**N O T I C E**

Applications are invited on the prescribed proforma for empanelment in the **Additional Ad hoc Panel** for the posts of **Assistant Professor in Journalism (English)** in the constituent colleges of the University of Delhi for the academic session 2019-20.

**Essential Qualification:**

Master's degree in Journalism and/or Mass Communication with NET/PhD in Journalism and/or Mass Communication, subject to fulfillment of other eligibility conditions

Those who are interested and fulfill the minimum eligibility requirements as laid down by the UGC/University of Delhi may submit their application form along with necessary self-attested documents and either a NET in Journalism and/or Mass Communication certificate or a NET in Journalism and/or Mass Communication exemption certificate in the Office of the Department of English, Arts Faculty Building, University of Delhi, Delhi – 110007 latest **by Friday, November 8, 2019. Late submissions will not be accepted under any circumstances.**

Candidates submitting their applications through post must ensure that these are received in the Department latest **by November 8, 2019, 5 p.m.**

The candidates, who have been awarded a PhD Degree in Journalism and/or Mass Communication in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for award of PhD Degree) Regulations 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of NET, subject to their production of an appropriate certificate in this respect.

Provided further that the award of degree to candidates registered for the PhD in Journalism and/or Mass Communication prior to 11 July, 2009 shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bylaws/Regulations of the

Institutions awarding the degree and such PhD degree holders shall be exempted from the requirement of NET, subject to the production of an appropriate certificate indicating the following:

- a) That the Ph.D. Degree of the candidate was awarded in the regular mode.
- b) That the evaluation of the Ph.D. thesis was done by at least two external examiners.
- c) That an open Ph.D. viva voce examination of the candidate was conducted.
- d) That the candidate had published two research papers from/based on his/her Ph.D. work out of which at least one was in a refereed journal.
- e) That the candidate had made at least two presentations in conferences/seminars based on his/her Ph.D. work.


It may be noted that the NET exemption certificate must be issued by one of the following: the Vice-Chancellor, the Pro-Vice-Chancellor, the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs), the Dean (Examinations), the Controller of Examinations or an equivalent official of the concerned University.

For candidates who have obtained their degree(s) from foreign University/Universities, equivalence certificate(s) from the Association of Indian Universities will be required as mandatory for empanelment.

**Those who are already on the Adhoc panel for the academic year 2019-20 need not apply again for this round of empanelment.**

It may be noted that the application form should be complete in all respects. Incomplete form/forms with inadequate documents will be summarily rejected. The Department reserves the right to reject the application, even if the candidate has been a part of the previous ad-hoc panel. The responsibility of providing the relevant documents/certificates lies entirely on the candidates.
