CRITERIA OF FIRST ADMISSION LIST FOR GENERAL/SC/ST/PWD & OBC CATEGORIES

Commerce

CATEGORY-I

94% and above marks in aggregate of Commerce stream i.e. Hindi/English and any three of Business Studies, Accounts, Economics & Mathematics.

CATEGORY-II

96% and above marks in aggregate of Commerce stream (one vocational subject relating to Commerce would be considered).

CATEGORY-III

98% marks and above in aggregate for Science & Arts stream (only one vocational subject would be considered)

Relaxation for OBC candidates 5%, for SC/ST 10% and for PWD candidates 5% for all the above categories.

Political Science

CATEGORY-I

81% and above marks in aggregate with one language and 03 academic subjects in Humanities with 75% and above marks in Pol.Science.

CATEGORY-II

88% and above marks in aggregate with one language, one vocational and 02 academic subjects in Humanities with atleast 75% marks in Pol.Science.

CATEGORY-III

88% and above marks in aggregate with one language and 03 subjects in Science/Commerce stream without Pol.Science.

Relaxation for OBC candidates 6%, for SC/ST 7% and for PWD candidates 7% for all the above categories.

Economics

CATEGORY-I

93.75% and above marks in 04 academic subjects with 1 language and any 03 subject from Science stream. Minimum 80% in Mathematics is compulsory.

CATEGORY-II

95.75% and above marks in 04 academic subjects with 1 language and any 03 subject from Commerce & Humanities stream. Minimum 80% in Mathematics is compulsory.

CATEGORY-III

98.75% and above marks in 04 academic subjects with 1 language and any 2 academic subject and any 01 of the following subjects : Physical Education, Fine Art, Dance & Music.

Relaxation for OBC candidates 3%, for SC/ST 5% and for PWD candidates 5% for all the above categories.

Psychology

CATEGORY-I

93% and above marks in aggregate (best of 04 subjects) with one language and any 03 of the following subjects : Economics, Pol. Science, History, Geography, Sociology, Philosophy, Mathematics & Psychology.

CATEGORY-II

95% and above marks in aggregate (with best of 04 subjects) with one language and any three subjects from Science or Commerce stream.

CATEGORY-III

98% and above marks in aggregate with one language and 02 academic subjects and any one of the following subjects : Home Science, Fine Arts, Agriculture, Computer Science, Informatics Practice, Physical Education, Music, Dance, Entrepreneurship.

Note : 01% concession in aggregate for students with minimum 80% marks in Psychology.

Relaxation for OBC candidates 5%, for SC/ST 5% and for PWD candidates 5% for all the above categories.

Geography

CATEGORY-I (For Humanities, Science & Commerce streams with Geography)

82% and above marks in best of four subjects (one language, three academic **OR**, two academic plus one of the following subjects i.e. Travel & Tourism, Graphic Design, Fine Arts, Geospatial Technology Computer Science and Informatics Practices) & 80% and above marks in Geography.

CATEGORY-II (For Humanities/Science/Commerce without Geography)

86% and above marks in best of four subjects i.e. one language, three academic **OR**, two academic plus one of the following subjects i.e. Travel & Tourism, Graphic Design, Fine Arts, Geospatial Technology, Computer Science and information Practices.

Note : 50% and above marks in Hindi/English language

Relaxation for OBC candidates 5%, for SC/ST 5% and for PWD candidates 5% for all the above categories.

Sociology

CATEGORY-I

85% and above marks in aggregate with one language plus any 03 subjects of the following :-

Sociology, Economics, Political Science, History, Geography, Mathematics, Psychology, Philosophy, Hindi Elective & English Elective.

CATEGORY-II

90% and above marks in aggregate with one language plus any 02 subjects of the following :-

Sociology, Economics, Political Science, History, Geography, Mathematics, Psychology, Philosophy, Hindi Elective & English Elective.

PLUS

Any one subject of the following :

Home Science, Fine Arts, Computer Science, Informatics Practices, Physical Education, Web and Multimedia Technology, Music, Dance, Accountancy, Commerce, Entrepreneurships & Business Studies.

CATEGORY-III

92% and above marks in aggregate with one language plus any 03 subjects of the following :-

Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Engineering Drawing, Economics, Office Secretaryship, Accounting and Auditing, Banking, Accountancy, Commerce, Computer Science, Informatics Practices, Entrepreneurship, Bio-Technology, Business Studies, Web and Multimedia technology, Physical Education, Home Science & Sociology.

Note

1. 70% and above marks in English for all the above three categories.
2. 05% concession in aggregate will be given to students who have secured 78% and above marks in Sociology in Class-XII examination for all the above three categories.

Relaxation for OBC candidates 5%, for SC/ST 5% and for PWD candidates 5% for all the above categories.

Journalism

CATEGORY-I

94% and above marks (best of 04 subjects) in academic subjects of Humanities stream -with at-least 02 of any of the following subjects : Economics, Political Science, History, Geography, Sociology, Psychology & Philosophy. Minimum 70% marks in English is compulsory.

CATEGORY-II

95% and above marks (best of 04 subjects) in academic subjects of Science stream -with at-least 02 of any of the following subjects : Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Mathematics, Engineering Drawing & Computer Science. Minimum 70% marks in English is compulsory.

CATEGORY-III

96% and above marks (best of 04 subjects) in academic subjects of Commerce stream -with at-least 02 of any of the following subjects : Mathematics, Economics, Business Studies & Accountancy. Minimum 70% marks in English is compulsory.

CATEGORY-IV

96% and above marks (best of 04 subjects) in 02 academic subjects and any one subject out of the following : Fine Arts, Painting, Multimedia, Dance, Music, Creative Writing and Translation Studies. Minimum 70% marks in English is compulsory.

Relaxation for OBC candidates 7%, for SC/ST 7% and for PWD candidates 7% for all the above categories.

History

CATEGORY-I:

76% and above marks in Humanities, 60% in History with one language and any 02 of the following subjects: Political Science, Sociology, Anthropology, Psychology, Geography, Economics, Mathematics, and Philosophy. Minimum Marks required in English is 65%

CATEGORY-II

77% and above marks for students from non-history in Humanities with one language and any 03 of the following subjects: Political Science, Sociology, Anthropology, Psychology, Geography, Economics, Mathematics, and Philosophy. Minimum Marks required in English is 65%

CATEGORY-III

79% and above marks in Science stream with 01 language and 03 of the following subjects :- Physics, Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry, Mechanical Drawing/Engineering Drawing and Computer Science. Minimum Marks required in English is 68%

CATEGORY-IV

82% and above marks for Commerce stream with 01 language and 03 of the following subjects :- Accounts, Mathematics, Business Studies, Economics and Commerce. Minimum Marks required in English is 70%

CATEGORY-V

92% and above marks with one language, one vocational and two academic subjects. Minimum Marks required in English is 90%

Relaxation for OBC candidates 5%, for SC/ST 5% and for PWD candidates 7% for all the above categories.

English

CATEGORY-I

88.5% and above marks in aggregate including English for Humanities stream.

CATEGORY-II

90% and above marks in aggregate including English for Science stream.

CATEGORY-III

91% and above marks in aggregate including English and any 2 academic subjects from any stream and one subject out of the following : Fine Arts, Painting, Physical Education, Agriculture, Entrepreneurship, Fashion Studies, Graphic, Information Practice, Healthcare Sc., Graphic Design & BPO skill.

CATEGORY-IV

95% and above marks in aggregate including English for Commerce stream.

Note : 5% relaxation to students having studied a second or Elective English paper in Class-XII along with the compulsory English paper.

Relaxation for OBC candidates 5%, for SC/ST 5% and for PWD candidates 5% for all the above categories.

Philosophy

CATEGORY-I

84% and above marks in aggregate with best four academic subjects (01 language and 03 academic subjects) & 75% and above marks in English.

Relaxation for OBC candidates 7%, for SC/ST 8% and for PWD candidates 10% for above category.

Mathematics

CATEGORY-I

93% or above in best of 04 academic subjects including Mathematics and English and any 02 of the following subjects :

Main List : Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Engineering Drawing, Economics, Political Science, History, Geography, Business Studies, Accountancy, Computer Science, Sociology, Psychology and Philosophy with 95% or above marks in Mathematics is compulsory.

CATEGORY-II

95% or above in best of 04 academic subjects including Mathematics and one language (English or Hindi) one academic subject from Main List and any 01 of the following subjects : Home Science , Fine Arts, Agriculture, Music, Physical Education, Dance and Entrepreneurship with 97% or above marks in Mathematics is compulsory.

Relaxation for OBC candidates 2%, for SC/ST 5% and for PWD candidates 5% for all the above categories.

Sanskrit

CATEGORY-I

50% and above marks in best of four subjects in Humanities stream and 50% and above marks in Sanskrit in Class-XII/X.

CATEGORY-II

55% and above marks in best of four subjects for Commerce/Science stream and 50% and above marks in Sanskrit in Class-XII/X.

For O.B.C. category :

CATEGORY-I

48% and above marks in best of four subjects in Humanities stream and 49% and above marks in Sanskrit in Class-XII/X.

CATEGORY-II

53% and above marks in best of four subjects for Commerce/Science stream and 50% and above marks in Sanskrit in Class-XII/X.

For SC/ST categories :

CATEGORY-I

49% and above marks in best of four subjects in Humanities stream and 49% and above marks in Sanskrit in Class-XII/X.

CATEGORY-II

54% and above marks in best of four subjects for Commerce/Science stream and 50% and above marks in Sanskrit in Class-XII/X.

For PWD category :

45% and above marks in best of four subjects and knowledge of marks in Sanskrit.

Hindi

67% and above marks in aggregate with all the 03 academic and 01 vocational subjects and atleast 68% & above marks in Elective Hindi or 72% & above marks in Core Hindi or 72% & above marks in Addl. Hindi at +2 level.


Note : Must have passed English upto 10+2 level.

Relaxation for OBC candidates 5%, for SC/ST 5% and for PWD candidates 7% for the above category.

Certificates (Original & Photostat) required at the time of admission :

1. Provisional Certificate of 12th Class
2. Mark-sheet of 12th class Examination.
3. Character Certificate
4. Migration Certificate (If, the candidate from other state)
5. Caste Certificate, if the student belongs to SC/ST/PWD and OBC (Non-creamy layer).
6. A certificate of having passed lower Hindi (upto class 8th -if exemption from compulsory Hindi is sought).
7. 03 passport size photographs.
