### CRITERIA OF FIRST ADMISSION LIST FOR GENERAL & OBC/SC/ST/PWD CATEGORIES

#### B.Com (Prog)

##### CATEGORY I

93% and above marks in aggregate for Commerce stream i.e. Hindi/English and any three of Business Studies, Accounts, Economics & Mathematics.

##### CATEGORY II

95% and above marks in aggregate of Science/Arts/Commerce stream with one vocational subject as per University norms..

Note : In all the above categories Mathematics must have been studied upto 10<sup>th</sup> standard.

For SC/ST(89-91%), For OBC (90-92%) & For PWD (88-90%) for all the above categories.

#### B.Com (Hons.)

##### CATEGORY I

95% and above marks in aggregate for Commerce i.e. one language and any three of Maths, Accounts, Economics & Business Studies..

##### CATEGORY-II

97% and above marks in aggregate of Science/Arts/Commerce stream with one vocational subject as per University norms.

Note : In all the above categories Mathematics must have been studied at +2 level.

For SC/ST(91-93%), For OBC (92-94%) & For PWD (90-92%) for all the above categories.

#### B.A.(Prog.) with "Advertising Sales Promotion & Sales Management"

##### CATEGORY I

87.75% and above marks in aggregate for Commerce/Science/Arts stream with three academic subjects (including one language) and one vocational subject.

For SC/ST(83%), For OBC (84%) & For PWD (82%).

#### B.Sc. (Hons) Mathematics

93.25% and above marks in best of 04 academic subjects including one language & Mathematics

Note : Computer Science, Informatics Practice/Information Technology will be the only vocational subjects to be included in calculating the best 04 subjects percentage.

For SC/ST (88%), For OBC (90%) & For PWD (87%).

88% and above marks in aggregate with one language and 03 subjects in Science/Commerce stream without Pol.Science.

For SC/ST (83-86-86%) & For PWD (82-85-85%) for all the above categories.

## B.A.(Hons) Economics

#### CATEGORY-I

96% and above marks in 04 academic subjects with 1 language and any 03 subject from Science, Commerce & Humanities stream.

#### CATEGORY-II

98.25% and above marks in 04 academic subjects with 1 language and 02 academic subjects and any 01 vocational subject.

Note : 80% and above marks in Mathematics is compulsory for all categories.

For SC/ST (90-92.25%), For OBC (91-93.25%) & For PWD (88-90.25) for all the above categories.

## B.A.(Hons) Psychology

General Category closed

### For SC/ST/OBC Categories

#### CATEGORY-I

85% and above marks in aggregate (best of 04 subjects) with one language and any 03 of the following subjects : Economics, Pol. Science, History, Geography, Sociology, Philosophy, Mathematics & Psychology.

#### CATEGORY-II

87% and above marks in aggregate (with best of 04 subjects) with one language and any three academic subjects from Science or Commerce stream.

#### CATEGORY-III

88% and above marks in aggregate with one language and 02 academic subjects and any one vocational subject

Note : 02% concession in aggregate for students with minimum 75% marks in Psychology.

For PWD (80-82-83%) for all the above categories.

B.A.(Hons) Sociology  
General Category closed

For OBC/SC/ST Categories

CATEGORY I

80% and above marks in aggregate with one language plus any 03 subjects of the following :-  
Sociology, Economics, Political Science, History, Geography, Psychology, Philosophy, Hindi Elective & English Elective.

CATEGORY-II

85% and above marks in aggregate with one language plus any 02 subjects of the following :-  
Sociology, Economics, Political Science, History, Geography, Mathematics, Psychology, Philosophy, Hindi Elective & English Elective.

PLUS

Any one subject of the following :

Home Science, Fine Arts, Computer Science, Informatics Practices, Physical Education, Web and Multimedia Technology, Music, Dance, Accountancy, Commerce, Entrepreneurships & Business Studies.

CATEGORY III

86% and above marks in aggregate with one language plus any 03 subjects of the following :-  
Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Engineering Drawing, Economics, Office Secretaryship, Accounting and Auditing, Banking, Accountancy, Commerce, Computer Science, Informatics Practices, Entrepreneurship, Bio-Technology, Business Studies, Web and Multimedia technology, Physical Education, Home Science & Sociology.

2. 05% concession in aggregate will be given to students who have secured 78% and above marks in Sociology in Class-XII examination for all the above three categories.

For PWD (79-83-85%) for all the above categories.

B.A.(Hons.) Geography  
General Category closed

For OBC Category

CATEGORY-I (For Humanities, Science & Commerce streams with Geography)

87% and above marks in best of four subjects (one language, three academic subjects OR two academic subjects, one language and one vocational subject & 82% and above marks in Geography is compulsory.

CATEGORY-II (For Science/Commerce without Geography)

89% and above marks in best of four subjects i.e. one language, three academic OR one language, two academic and one vocational subject for candidates without Geography.

For SC/ST (86-88%) & For PWD (84-86%) for all the above categories.

## B.A.(Hons) History

General Category closed

81% and above marks in Humanities/Science stream (one language + 03 academic subjects)

#### CATEGORY-II

#### CATEGORY-III

87% and above marks with one language, 02 academic subjects and 01 vocational subject from any stream

Note : 65% and above marks in English for all categories.

For SC/ST(79-81-85%), & For PWD (74-76-80%) for all the above categories.

## B.A.(Hons)Philosophy

#### CATEGORY I

86% and above marks in aggregate with best four academic subjects (01 language and 03 academic subjects) & 72% and above marks in English

For SC/ST (81%), For OBC (82%) & For PWD (80%).

## B.A.(Hons.) Hindi

72% and above marks in aggregate with all the 03 academic and 01 vocational subjects and atleast 70% & above marks in Elecive Hindi or 72% & above marks in Core Hindi or 72% & above marks in Addl. Hindi at +2 level.

Note : Must have passed English upto 10+2 level.

For SC/ST/OBC categories (65%) & For PWD (64%).

## B.A.(Hons) Sanskrit

#### CATEGORY-I

53% and above marks in best of four subjects in Humanities stream (50% and above marks in Sanskrit in Class-XII/X).

#### CATEGORY II

58% and above marks in best of four subjects for Commerce/Science stream (50% and above marks in Sanskrit in Class-XII/X).

Note : 50% and above marks in Sanskrit in Class-XII/X for all categories.

For SC/ST/OBC (48-53%) & For PWD (45%) as above categories.

## English

General & OBC Category closed

### For SC/ST Category

#### CATEGORY-I

83.5% and above marks in aggregate including English for Humanities stream

#### CATEGORY-II

84.5% and above marks in aggregate including English for Science stream.

#### CATEGORY-III

86.5% and above marks in aggregate including English and any 2 academic subjects from any stream and one subject out of the following : *Fine Arts, Painting, Physical Education, Agriculture, Entrepreneurship, Fashion Studies, Graphic, Information Practice, Healthcare Sc., Graphic Design & BPO skill*

#### CATEGORY-IV

90.5% and above marks in aggregate including English for Commerce stream.

Note : 5% relaxation to students having studied a second or Elective English paper in Class-XII along with the compulsory English paper

For PWD ((82.5-83.5-85.5-89.5%) for all the above categories.

## Journalism

General Category closed

### For OBC Category

#### CATEGORY-I

88% and above marks (best of 04 subjects including English) with atleast 02 of any of the following subjects : Economics, Political Science, History, Geography, Sociology, Psychology & Philosophy. Minimum 70% marks in English is compulsory.

#### CATEGORY-II

89% and above marks (best of 04 subjects including English) with atleast 02 of any of the following subjects : Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Mathematics, Engineering Drawing & Computer Science. Minimum 70% marks in English is compulsory

#### CATEGORY-III

90% and above marks (best of 04 subjects including English) with atleast 02 of any of the following subjects : Mathematics, Economics, Business Studies & Accountancy. Minimum 70% marks in English is compulsory.

For SC/ST (89-90-91%) & For PWD (85.5-86-90%) for all the above categories.

## I M P O R T A N T
