Two Guest Faculty Positions (1-SC, 1-ST) are available at the Department of Environmental Studies for teaching the below mentioned subjects in Semester IV (January – May 2020).

The Guest Faculty will be paid honorarium of Rs. 1500/- per lecture subject to a maximum of Rs. 50,000/- per month.

Educational Qualifications:

Qualifications for Guest Teachers will be same, as prescribed for the regular teachers of the University in UGC's regulations i.e.

Educational Qualifications:

i) Essential

1. Environmental and Resource Economics
Ph.D in Environmental Studies/ Economics
2. Environmental Communication and Education
Ph.D in Environmental Studies/ Mass Communication

Candidates must have secured at least 55% marks in the Master's Degree. The candidate must have cleared NET conducted by UGC, CSIR.

ii) Desirable

Teaching, Research, in a reputed organization;
Papers presented at Conferences and/or published in refereed journals.

How to apply

- Applications (with passport size photograph) on prescribed format stating qualifications (class 12th standard onward) may be sent to the Head of the Department of Environmental Studies, University of Delhi, Delhi 110007 by registered or speed post. Applications can also be submitted personally in the office of the Department of Environmental Studies, Self-attested copies of all certificates and publications must also be enclosed with the application.

Last date of receiving applications: application should reach the Department of Environmental Studies latest by **11 December 2019**.

Candidates who have applied to the advertisement of 4th September 2019 need not apply again.

- The applications will be screened and only short-listed candidates will be called for interview. The selection will be based on the performance in interview + Academic career.
- Selection of candidates shall be provisional and approval of appointment will be given by the University, subject to verification of antecedents or documents submitted by a candidate.

GENERAL NOTE

The Candidates, who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in University' Colleges/Institutes. Provided further, the award of degree to candidates registered for the M.Phil./Ph.D, programme prior to 11 July 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/By- laws/Regulations of the Institutions awarding the degree and the Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutes subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

Ph.D. degree of the candidate awarded in regular mode only: Evaluation of the Ph.D. thesis by at least two external examiners: Open Ph.D. viva-voce of the candidate had been conducted:

Candidate has published two research papers from/based on his/her Ph.D. work out of which at least one must be in a refereed journal;

Candidate has made at least two presentations in conferences/seminars, based on his/her Ph.D, work,

A relaxation of 5% may be provided at the Graduate and Masters Level for the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes/Differently-abled (Physically and Visually differently-abled) /Other Backward Classes (OBC) (Non- creamy layer) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for

assessing good academic records during direct recruitment to faculty positions. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedures.

A relaxation of 5% may be provided, from 55% to 50% of the marks to the Ph.D. Degree holders, who have obtained their Master's Degree prior to 19 September 1991. Relevant grade which is regarded as equivalent of 55% wherever the grading system is followed by a recognized university shall also be considered eligible.
