

ADVANCED DIPLOMA IN SERBIAN (One Year Course)

Revision and consolidation of grammar, translation of articles from newspapers, literary and scientific texts on literature written in Serbian.

Each student must submit a translation of a Yugoslav article on a subject of his / her specialization by 31st January as well as his / her essay of five typed pages on a selected topics written in Serbian.
