My interests lie in different aspects of what such analyses can tell us about the learning and teaching of foreign languages; in a detailed manner, of Italian. - Examining learner production and working towards bridging gaps between didactics and applied linguistics. Using this to form future teachers of Italian. - Working on how a linguistic (learner) corpus may be incorporated in learner centred teaching
