## FUNDING FOR PROGRAMMES/ ACTIVITIES

Under XI plan, Gandhi Bhawan has a provision of providing modest funds upto Rs. 10,000/- to colleges for holding programmes/ activities under the auspices of Gandhi Study Circle. Proposals are invited for organizing programmes/ activities viz. Debate and Quiz competition, Poster and Slogan competition, Lectures on Gandhian Philosophy, Street Plays on Gandhiji, Peace Marches, Programme on communal harmony, Seminar, Workshops, Conferences or any other programme/ activities promoting Gandhian philosophy and action with a primary aim of spreading Mahatma Gandhi's message of Truth, Non-violence, Peace and Harmony among the youth.

In the earlier communication sent by us vide ref. no. GB/11/365 & 366 dated 11.11.2011, the last date of submission of proposals was 25<sup>th</sup> November 2011. The date for submitting proposals has been extended to **15<sup>th</sup> February 2012**.

The broad guidelines for the expenditure to be incurred are as under:

1.	Honorarium to Speaker Conveyance to Speaker	Rs. 1,000/- Rs. 500/-
2.	Prizes: First Prize Second Prize Third Prize	Rs. 1,000/- Rs. 750/- Rs. 500/-
3.	Refreshment should not exceed	Rs. 40/- per head
4.	Miscellaneous Expenditure - posters, banners, stationery, books on Gandhiji, conveyance charges, photocopy, etc.	

After conducting the programme, the bills with the report and photographs of the programme should be submitted to the Office of Gandhi Bhawan by **20.3.2012**.
