M.Phil. Programme in Linguistics

The M.Phil. Programme in Linguistics consists of two parts:

Part I-Course Work

Course P-1 Current Trends in Linguistic Theory (100 Marks)

Current trends in Linguistics is the sub-domains of phonetics and phonology, morphology, syntax, semantics and pragmatics, sociolinguistics and psycholinguistics.

P-2 Reading in Linguistics & Term Paper (100 Marks)

Course work/assignment on course work & presentation/two term papers in the focused area under the Supervision of a Faculty member (**As decided by the M.Phil. Committee**)

P-3 Research Methodology (100 Marks)

Formulation of hypothesis aspects of field work; writing an abstract; planning a dissertation/thesis; chapter divisions; qualitative and quantitative methods of analysis; references; standard observations etc. logical deductions

Part II: Dissertation (200 Marks)

Only those students who obtain at least 50% marks in Part I of the course are qualified to undertake dissertation work.
