

DU-UoE On-Line Lecture Exchange Programme

The second installment of the pilot lecture exchange series between DU and UoE was held on 22nd April 2013 with enthusiastic and energetic participation from the students of both Delhi and Edinburgh. Leading the discussion from our end, Prof. Harish Trivedi kept the audience enthralled with his extensive and insightful knowledge of the place of Indian literature in an increasingly interconnected world. The lecture, entitled "Reading Indian Literature in a Globalized World", was screened for the students on 18th April at The Studio. Prof. David Farrier, Department of English Literature, University of Edinburgh, initiated and moderated the discussion for Edinburgh and also contributed to it with his extremely versatile understanding of postcolonial issues. An exchange of this kind reflects on a positive integration of the creation and dissemination of knowledge sources in ways that transcend spatial and temporal restrictions.
