VI. The University Grants Commission vide Public Notice date 15th January, 2016 has stated as under:

The Commission had sought the comments of the Statutory Councils. The responses so far, received do not endorse the idea of allowing the students to pursue two degree simultaneously. Therefore, the universities shall conduct their programmes in accordance with the First Degree and Master Degree Regulations, 2003 prescribed by the UGC and also follow the norms and parameters prescribed by the Statutory Council, wherever relevant.

The Committee after detailed deliberations, resolved that Mrs. Rupali Gupta pursued two degree courses i.e. B.P.T. (Bachelor of Physio-therapy) degree programme from Chaudhary Charan Singh University, Meerut in the year 1999-2004 vide Errolment number 9968376 and Roll no. 9461040 and B.Com. degree programme from Delhi University in the year 2000-2004 through School of Correspondence Courses & Continuing Education vide Enrolment number 8835/2000 and Roll no. 250005 which is in violation of the resolution no. 40 dated 24.04.1997 and resolution No. 49 dated 14.05.1975. of the Academic Council of the University of Delhi.

The Committee recommended that the degree of B.Com. conferred on Mrs. Rupali Gupta in the year 2000-2004 may be withdrawn in pursuance of the provision of Statute 15 of the Statutes of the University of Delhi quoted below:

"The Court may, on the recommendation of the Executive Council, by a resolution passed with the concurrence of not less than two-thirds of the members voting, withdraw any degree or diploma conferred by the University".
