

FULL TIME M.PHIL COURSE IN RUSSIAN

SYLLABUS FOR PHASE-I (M.PHIL. IN RUSSIAN)

DURATION: ONE ACADEMIC YEAR

PHASE-I will consist of the following courses:

Course I Research Methodology

Time 3 hrs.

Marks: 100

- To acquaint students with the research techniques current in the field of Russian language and literature: students will be trained to collect the relevant material, to classify and evaluate it, to formulate and verify hypothesis.
- To enable them to write a dissertation through short programmes in given courses in which sectioning, foot noting, referencing and cross referencing and preparing selected extensive bibliography with the library procedure in locating primary and secondary sources as well as the technique of reviewing the literature in specific areas will be taught.

Course II Modern Russian Language and Linguistics

3 hrs.

Marks: 100

Course III Social and Cultural History

3 hrs.

Marks: 100

Course IV History of Russian Literature

3 hrs.

Marks: 100

Total Marks: 400

PHASE-II (DISSERTATION): ONE ACADEMIC YEAR

Marks: 100

Note: 25% marks are earmarked for internal assessment in respect of Phase-I Papers.

With regard to phase-II 25% marks are earmarked for viva-voce in respect of dissertation.

ATTENDANCE: The students will be required to have 66% of the total number of lectures and seminars held in each course.

MODE OF EVALUATION:

- Course work: the evaluation of the candidates for the four courses will be based on written tests or assignment given by the teacher / teachers
- Dissertation: the dissertation will be evaluated by the Supervisor(s) and another teacher appointed by the M-Phil Committee.
- 25% marks in each Course will be awarded for Internal Assessment which will be based on attendance, periodical tests and seminars.

Eligibility Conditions:

The minimum eligibility conditions for admission to the M-Phil (Russian) Course in the Department shall be as follows: good academic record with a first or high second class (equivalent Grade) Master's degree or an equivalent degree of foreign University in Russian.

There will also be an entrance examination (Written & Oral).

- The course is conducted as per provisions of Ordinance VI of the University of Delhi.
