

## Chemistry Ph.D.Scholar selected for 67th Lindau Nobel Laureate Meeting



Ms. Monika Patel, a Ph.D. student under supervision of Prof. Akhilesh K. Verma, Department of Chemistry, University of Delhi has been selected for participation in the 67th Lindau Nobel Laureate Meeting during 25-30 June 2017 to be held in Germany.

Once every three years, 30–40 Nobel Laureates in Chemistry assemble at Lindau, Germany to meet the next generation of leading young researchers/scientists (undergraduates, Ph.D. students, and post-doc researchers) from all over the world. The Lindau Nobel Laureate Meetings promote the exchange among scientists of different generations, cultures, and disciplines.

21 young researchers (6 MSc +13 Ph.D. + 2 Post Doc) have been selected for this meeting. Ms. Monika Patel, during her Ph.D., has published more than 18 publications in high impact journal including Acc. Chem. Res. (Imp. Fact. > 22).
