

"TAMAE KAMI MEMORIAL MERIT SCHOLARSHIP"

1. There shall be a scholarship called 'Tamae Kami Memorial Merit Scholarship' of the value of Rs. 200/- p.m. to be awarded out of the annual income accruing from the Endowment Fund of Rs. 20,000/- endowed by Ms. Yoko Kami, a visiting Lecturer in the Department of Japanese Studies, in memory of her mother Mrs. Tamae Kami.
2. The Scholarship shall be awarded to a deserving student of One Year Intensive Advanced Diploma in Japanese Language (Full-time).
3. The scholarship shall be awarded on the recommendation of the Committee of Courses of Japanese Studies of the Department of Chinese and Japanese Studies which will follow the same procedure of selection as is followed for the award of other merit-based language scholarships with the Department.
4. The Scholarship shall be awarded every year and shall be tenable for nine months only from 1st August of an academic year to 30th April, of the same academic year (next calendar year).
5. If it should appear at any time to the Head of the Department of Chinese and Japanese Studies that a scholar has failed to make satisfactory progress or has been guilty of gross misconduct after due warning in writing, his/her scholarship may be suspended or withdrawn on the specific recommendation of the Committee of Courses of Japanese Studies of the Department of Chinese and Japanese Studies.
6. No student shall be eligible for this scholarship if he/she already holds a scholarship awarded by Delhi University or any other University or the Central Government or any State Government or a Private Body.
7. In case a scholar under this endowment accepts any other scholarship/financial assistance from any other source, he/she shall be required to surrender this scholarship and shall be required to refund the amount received by him/her on account of this scholarship from the date he/she accepted the other scholarship/financial assistance.
8. In case a scholar discontinues the studies without valid reasons, he/she shall be required to refund the amount received by him/her on account of the scholarship.
9. In case a scholarship falls vacant during the pendency of the same it may be reawarded to another student on the recommendations of the Committee of Courses of Japanese Studies of the Department of Chinese and Japanese Studies for the residuary period.
10. Any amount accruing from interest from the endowment and not spent in any year shall be added to the corpus of the endowment fund.
11. The payment of the scholarship amount will be made to the scholar through the Head of the Department of Chinese and Japanese Studies on the presentation of a bill and a certificate to the effect that during the period covered in the bill, the scholar was not in receipt of any other scholarship or financial assistance from any other source and also that he/she was regular in attendance and his/her progress at studies was satisfactory.
