"BALMOKAND ARSH MALSIANI MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS"

- 1) There shall be two Scholarships* known as 'Balmokand Arsh Malsiani Memorial Scholarships' each of the value of Rs. 135/-** p.m. payable out of the interest on the funds amounting to Rs. 22,000/- endowed by Mrs. Raj Arsh w/o Late Shri Balmokand Arsh, F.4/11, Model Town, Delhi-110009.
- 2) One Scholarship shall be awarded every year to a student who secures the highest percentage of marks from amongst the applicants in B.A.(Hons.) Urdu/B.A.(Pass) with Urdu Examination of this University and joins the M.A. Course in Urdu.
- 3) The Scholarship shall be tenable for two years but will be renewed for the final year subject to satisfactory performance at the previous year examination.
- 4) a) No student shall be eligible for the award of this scholarship if he or she already possesses a Scholarship awarded by the University of Delhi or any other University or the Central Government or any State of India or a Private Body other than a freship.
b) In case a scholar under this endowment is awarded any other Scholarship or gets financial aid from any other source, he shall be required to refund the amount received by him/her on this account from the date he/she was awarded any other Scholarship or gets financial aid.
- 5) If it should appear at any time during the tenure of the award that the Scholar has failed to make satisfactory progress or has been found guilty of gross misconduct or has been irregular in attendance, he/she shall, after due warning in writing, be reported by the Principal/Head of the Institution of his/her College to the Academic Council which may reduce, suspend or withdraw the Scholarship.
- 6) The Scholarship shall be awarded by the Academic Council on the recommendations of a Selection Committee constituted as follows:-
 1. The Dean, Faculty of Arts
 2. The Head of the Department of Urdu.
- 7) The payment of the Scholarship amount shall be made to the Scholar through the Principal of his/her College on presentations of a bill and a certificate to the effect that during the period covered in the bill the awardee was not in receipt of any other Scholarship/Financial assistance from any other source.
- 8) Any amount accruing as interest from the endowment if not spent in any year shall be added to the corpus of the endowment fund.
