**Interview Schedule**

This is to notify to all concerned that the Department of English, University of Delhi will conduct interviews for admission to PhD in English on 5<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> October, 2018 (Friday, Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday), detailed schedule of which will be announced later.

Shortlisted candidates will be required to bring 10 hard copies of their proposals at the time of interview. At the time of interview, the candidates are required to discuss their research interest area through a presentation before a duly constituted committee. The interview shall also consider the following aspects:

- a. The candidate possesses the competence for the proposed research
- b. The research work can be suitably undertaken at the University
- c. The proposed area of research can contribute to new/additional knowledge.

JRF/NET and other category candidates as per Ordinance VI Clause C of University of Delhi may directly appear at the Departmental Interview. Please note however that the candidates who have qualified NET/JRF or other National Eligibility test as per Ordinance VI, Clause C, subsequent to registration shall not be called for the interview.

It is advisable that the candidates inform the Selection Committee at the time of interview if they have consulted any member of the faculty regarding supervision.

It is mandatory to bring the Admit Card, Registration Form and Identity Proof (Adhar card/ Driving license/ PAN card/Voter identity card/Passport/College identity card).

Kindly note that **no** TA/DA for appearing in the interview will be paid to any candidate.
