

## **FULL TIME M-PHIL COURSE IN BULGARIAN\***

The M-Phil Programme aims at equipping the candidates with the necessary level of theoretical knowledge and competence in the subject. The candidates will be encouraged to widen their horizon and inculcate independent work in the subject concerned for further research.

### **Course Duration**

The M-Phil programme will be for two years. During the first year the students are expected to complete their course work (Phase I) and the next year for writing the dissertation (Phase II). The maximum period permissible for completion of course work will be two years. However, in exceptional cases, within the framework of the Ordinance VI an extension may be granted by the M-Phil Committee.

### **PHASE-I (ONE ACADEMIC YEAR)**

The Phase – I will comprise of the following courses:

**Course I Research Methodology 3 hrs. Marks: 100**

**Course II Literary Criticism 3 hrs. Marks: 100**

**Course III Social and Cultural History of Bulgaria 3 hrs. Marks: 100**

**Course IV History of Bulgarian Literature 3 hrs. Marks: 100**

**PHASE-II (DISSERTATION): ONE ACADEMIC YEAR Marks: 100**

**Note:** 25% marks earmarked for internal assessment in respect of Phase-I papers.

With regard to phase-II 25% marks are earmarked for viva-voce related to dissertation.

**ATTENDANCE:** The students will be required to participate actively in 66% of the total number of lectures and seminars held in each course.

### **MODE OF EVALUATION:**

- Course work: the evaluation of the candidates will be based on written tests and assignment given by the teacher / teachers
- Dissertation: the dissertation will be evaluated by the supervisor(s) and another teacher appointed by the M-Phil Committee.
- 25% marks will be awarded for Internal Assessment which will be based on attendance, periodical tests and seminars.

**While adhering to the above programme structure as mentioned above, the detailed contents of each course will be prepared by the Course-in-Charge**

### **ELIGIBILITY**

-Good academic record with a First or High Second Class (equivalent Grade) Master's degree or an equivalent degree of foreign University in the subject concerned.

**Bulgarian or with at least 60% marks in Advanced Diploma (part-time) course in Bulgarian.**

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-M.A. in Russian

with at least 55% marks and Bulgarian as optional subject.

**-ADMISSION PRODEDURE:**

**All candidates shall have to pass an Entrance Exam (Written and Oral)**

- The course is conducted as per provisions of Ordinance VI of the University of Delhi.
